RULES FOR LA FLEET WEEK® EXPO



No fireworks, explosives, or flammable liquids.



No weapons of any type nor other defensive sprays will be permitted.



No UAS/Drones
L.A.M.C. 63.44 (B)8



No coolers, glass containers, or ice chests.



No skateboards, in-line skates, roller skates, bicycles, or scooters



No outside food or drinks.



No pets are allowed except for service animals.



No illegal drugs/paraphernalia including marijuana accompanied with a medical marijuana card.



No gang-related, violent, obscene, explicit, or suggestive clothing, or clothing that promotes terrorism, acts of violence or subjugation of a person or persons.



All persons will be subject to strict security procedures including metal detection and possible pat-downs.

RULES FOR LA FLEET WEEK® SHIP TOURS



No fireworks, explosives, or flammable liquids.



No weapons of any type nor other defensive sprays will be permitted.



Closed-toed shoes or back-strap sandals **REQUIRED**.



No food, drinks, coolers, glass containers, or ice chests.



No pets of any kind, including service animals, are allowed aboard any of the ships.



No large bags of ANY type are allowed on the vessels, including large camera bags, backpacks, purses, diaper bags, etc.



No UAS/Drones

No camera tripods or cameras equipped with lenses that exceed 100mm.



No strollers, skateboards, in-line skates, roller skates, bicycles, or scooters



No electronic cigarettes or illegal drugs/paraphernalia including marijuana accompanied with a medical marijuana card.



No gang-related, violent, obscene, explicit, or suggestive clothing, or clothing that promotes terrorism, acts of violence or subjugation of a person or persons.



No "Smart Glasses" or any recording eyewear.



While no wheelchair access is available, an equivalency experience will be offered upon request.



Tours are not recommended for children under 5 years old, or guests not physically able to walk through tight spaces and up/down steep ladders.



All persons will be subject to strict security procedures before accessing the vessels, including metal detection and possible pat-downs.



Government-issued identification is required for all visitors.

"By entering, you voluntarily assume all risks and dangers incident to attending LA Fleet Week, including the risk of lost, stolen or damaged property or personal injury. The planners of LA Fleet Week may eject or refuse entry to the holder for violation of venue rules, illegal activity, misconduct or failure to comply with any and all security measures. Security measures will be in effect including magnetometers and bag checks. Only small ladies' purses and small camera bags will be admitted. No animals (w/ exception of service dogs), backpacks, banners (large or in poor taste), beach balls, bottles, cans, containers of any kind, contraband, fireworks, GoPros, laptops, large bags, laser pointers, noisemakers, outside food & drink, oversized packages, projectiles, weapons, audio recording equipment, video cameras, professional cameras with lenses longer than 6", Tablets/iPads, school bags, sticks/poles/selfie sticks or other item(s) determined to be unacceptable by LA Fleet Week planners will not be permitted. If any prohibited items are revealed during search, the patron(s) will be permitted to return to their vehicle with the item(s) or they can dispose of the item(s). The venue will not store any personal belongings or items of any type. Management reserves the right to close venue or cancel events for any reason including weather, maintenance, security requirements, capacity, or any other cause deemed necessary for public safety. By attending the event, you grant LA Fleet Week, its planners, affiliates, and sponsors the right in perpetuity to use the bearers name, photograph, video, voice or likeness in any promotional material and/or social media, without notice or payment. Commercial photography or video of any sorts is not permitted. You hereby acknowledge that the premise is not a traditional events venue and may include bright lights, video, and loud noise, as such, the premises contains certain inherent risk of injury, which the bearer hereby knowingly assumes. The bearer further releases the Pacific Battleship Center, Port of Los Angeles, its planning affiliates, employees, officers, or agents from any and all claims, causes of action and liabilities of any nature whatsoever the bearer may incur or have against any of them which may arise out of or in connection with any action occurring on or related to the premises."
